1. Introduction

They may support:

These cookies do not collect information for advertising or marketing purposes.

Website Improvement Cookies

We do not currently use analytics or performance cookies on this website.

If we ever introduce analytics that use cookies or similar technologies, we will ask for your consent first through a clear notice on this website, and we will update this policy before doing so. Where a tool can work without cookies, we will prefer that option.

4. Cookies We Do Not Use

Unless specifically stated otherwise, Revenant Systems does not use cookies for:

- Selling personal information
- Behavioural advertising
- Building advertising profiles
- Tracking users across unrelated websites

5. Managing Cookies

Most web browsers allow you to control cookies through browser settings.

You can:

- Change cookie preferences

Please note that disabling certain cookies may affect website functionality.

6. Third-Party Cookies
